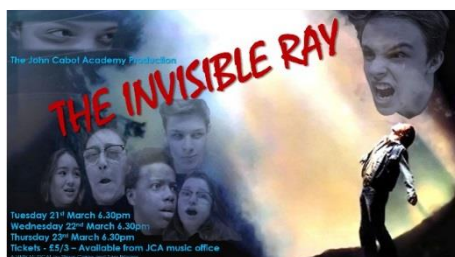


Lesson Scores: Top 10 Students
