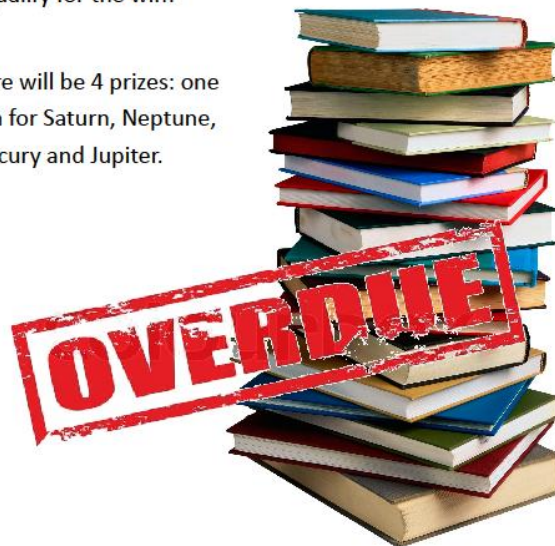
## Overdue Library Book Tutor Competition
