Parents of students in Jupiter Community will know that Mrs Price is the teaching Head of Community, supported by Mrs Archibald as the non teaching Head of Community.

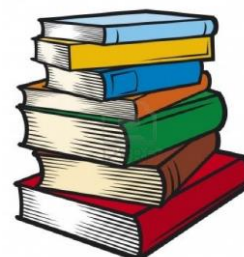
