Years 7-11

Students in Years 7-11 are expected to wear the Academy uniform.

Items / styles that should not be worn are listed alongside what should be worn.

Uniform should at all times be smart and in a good state of repair.

Please note:

If students attend school choosing to wear incorrect uniform and refuse to wear the clean reasonable replacement that we can offer, students will be isolated. If there are exceptional circumstances and a note has been supplied from home, students will be given time to purchase the correct item(s) without isolation.

Tie* JCA clip-on tie.

Blazer* Grey, blue piping to lapels with school badge embroidered onto pocket.

Trousers Black trousers with a crease. Jeans or other fashion styles are not

permitted.

Shirt White, long or short sleeve, buttoning to the neck to be worn with a tie.

Skirt* Blue, tartan skirt. Can be worn instead of trousers. Only available

through Trutex.

Tights Black, grey or neutral.

Socks White, black, dark blue or grey.

School shoes Black, substantial (not trainers, daps or boots).

Optional: See guidance below on acceptable styles of shoe.

Jumper* Dark blue, v-neck, with blue piping at the neck, only to be worn under the

blazer.

Belt Plain black with a discreet plain buckle or clasp.

General Uniform Instructions for Boys and Girls

Hair No ornaments such as flowers, bows, elaborate hair bands, etc. Extreme hair

colours are not permitted and if hair is dyed it must be within the natural

range of hair colours.

Jewellery No jewellery may be worn except a watch, religious symbol or ear stud (no

more than one in each ear and no hoop earrings). Facial or tongue piercings

are not permitted.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED:

i) Facial, nose or tongue piercings; ii) Make-up should be subtle and hardly visible; iii)
Hooded, leather or denim jackets. iv) No daps, trainers or boots. Acceptable styles can be seen on the school website.

Note: Current Year 11 students beginning the school year in Sept 2017 are permitted to wear the previous JCA school uniform as outlined in the uniform policy for 2016. A copy of this is available on request.

Socks JCA Blue football socks and white indoor sport socks.

Trainers White or black non-marking footwear.

Football Boots Substantial boots, any colour.

Students must wear shoes (not trainers, daps or boots) to and from school and during lessons.

A range of additional items are also available (leggings, fleece layers and sports jackets).

Jewellery, including ear studs, must NOT be worn for PE or Games. Parents are strongly advised that Health and Safety issues make <u>facial and body piercing</u> impracticable in a school working environment and are therefore not allowed as part of our uniform.

A letter or note from home is required if students are unable to take part in Physical Education at any point in the school year.

Shoes for Boys and Girls

Shoes must be plain black and can have laces, be slip-on or have a velcro strap; brief sample of acceptable shoe styles is shown here. These styles are advertised for sale as boys' and girls' shoes. Trainers, sport shoes, plimsolls or pumps are **not** acceptable, **neither** are boots **nor** shoes with high heels.
